Luke 17:11-19

11 Now on his way to Jerusalem, Jesus traveled along the border between Samaria and Galilee. 12 As he was going into a village, ten men who had leprosy met him. They stood at a distance 13 and called out in a loud voice, "Jesus, Master, have pity on us!"

14 When he saw them, he said, "Go, show yourselves to the priests." And as they went, they were cleansed.
15 One of them, when he saw he was healed, came back,

praising God in a loud voice. 16 He threw himself at Jesus' feet and thanked him—and he was a Samaritan.

17 Jesus asked, "Were not all ten cleansed? Where are the other nine? 18 Has no one returned to give praise to God except this foreigner?" 19 Then he said to him, "Rise and go; your faith has made you well."

Learning to see His leading

1 Corinthians 13:11-13

11 When I was a child, I talked like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I put the ways of childhood behind me. 12 For now we see only a reflection as in a mirror; then we shall see face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I am fully known. 13 And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love.

Reflection

As we commenced our Esther teaching series last month, we were reminded of how often in our lives "coincidences" happen, and we wonder: "was that

God talking/directing /nudging me?". Often, we are unable to sense God's specific directing – but as we grow in faith, trusting our heavenly Father, we can possibly start being more aware of how He is directing us and feel more confident in noticing "coincidences". The scripture above speaks of maturing and how we aren't able to "see" everything – only seeing part of the picture but be encouraged as there will be a time when we will be able to see and know everything.

Father God, thank You for your Word which is so encouraging and relevant to our walk with You. As we, your family in St Peter's follow your leading, taking steps of faith along the way, would you encourage and equip us as part of Your Body in Evesham. May we show respect and love to each other growing to reflect your Glory, honouring Your Name.
